Thankfully, all of Caesar's medical conditions were treatable. His tumors were benign, and he was asymptomatic to both tick-related illnesses. Caesar was treated and joined our Foster Program, where he proved to be a good patient throughout his healing process.

Caesar found his new family.

Even after all that he'd endured, Caesar showed us that he was ready to love again. He thrived in foster care, and won the hearts of his foster parents, who realized Caesar was home! They adopted him.



As uncomfortable as she was, Snowball trusted the compassionate hands of our medical staff.


